TRANSCRIPTION

Jeg traf strax tyske Venner her: Jæger¹ Palme² og Turk³ og blev saaledes strax ført ind i Alt. Som vild Fremmed maae man i Venedig staae som falden fra S[k]yerne. Den heele Dag har været lutter Nydelse for mig, det ene Skjønne vexlede med det andet, og hertil kom endnu at jeg fik Breve fra Moder og Rose, hendes Brev læste jeg i Aften paa Lidoen. Jeg var der syntes det mig som paa dansk Kyst.
